Community Action for Capable Youth Award for participation in National Youth Violence Prevention Week April 2016

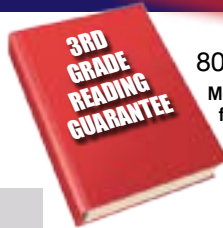
