



INKSTER PREPARATORY ACADEMY UNIFORM CLOTHING POLICY

To enable students to reach high academic standards, INKSTER PREPARATORY ACADEMY has put in place a **MANDATORY** dress code policy designed to reduce distractions and competitions by, among and between students.

It is the position of the Board of Directors of INKSTER PREPARATORY ACADEMY that implementing a simple, flexible, cost effective dress code promotes student learning and increased academic instruction time.

Interpretation of the dress code is at the school leaders or designee discretion and the decision is final.

General Attire for Girls

- Skirts, jumpers, skorts: navy, black, and khaki. No shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- Maroon polo shirt with Inkster Preparatory Academy logo.
- Pants, capris: navy, black, and khaki dress pants. No cargo pants, corduroy, leggings, skinny jeans or skinny uniform pants.
- Shorts: navy, black, and khaki no shorter than 1.5 inches above the knee.
- Cardigan Sweater: maroon, black, and khaki. Solid colors only, no logos.
- Tights: navy, black, white or khaki, solid colors only.
- Shoes: black or brown dress shoes or gym shoes. Open toes or open back shoes are not permitted.

- Long sleeve shirts may be worn under short sleeve uniform shirts but must be a solid color. Hooded shirts are not permitted underneath uniform shirt.
- No hoodies are to be worn in the building.
- No headgear to be worn in the building.

General Attire for Boys

- Pants: navy, black, and khaki dress pants with a belt. No cargo pants, corduroy or skinny jeans.
- Maroon polo shirt with Inkster Preparatory Academy logo.
- Shorts: navy, black, and khaki no shorter than 1.5 inches above the knee.
- Cardigan Sweater: maroon, black, gray, and khaki. Solid colors only, no logos.
- Shoes: black or brown dress shoes or gym shoes. Open toes or open back shoes are not permitted.

- Long sleeve shirts may be worn under short sleeve uniform shirts but must be a solid color. Hooded shirts are not permitted underneath uniform shirt.
- No hoodies are to be worn in the building.
- No headgear is to be worn in the building.

I. Discipline.

Parents are required to ensure that their children arrive on each and every school day wearing the proper uniform of INKSTER PREPARATORY ACADEMY. If a student appears at school without the complete school uniform,

First Offense, the child's parent(s) will be called and informed that the child is not properly dressed in the school uniform. The parent must assure that the child will be sent to school thereafter with the proper school uniform.

If a **Second Offense** occurs during the school year, the child's parent will be called and requested to pick up the child.

If a **Third Offense** occurs, the child's parent will be requested to attend the next regularly scheduled Board meeting to explain the reason for non-compliance.

If there is a **Fourth Offense** during the school year, the child may be suspended for up to 10 days.

II. Students In Need.

If there is a student who is not financially able to comply with the dress code and uniform policy, the Parent of the student shall inform the Board and/or school director. Efforts will be made to provide the student with uniforms through a grant or other method.

III. Appeal Discipline To Board.

If at anytime you disagree with a decision made by the Administration regarding enforcement of the dress code, you may request to appear before the Board of Directors at the regularly scheduled time for meetings and bring your concerns to the Board.
